Background

Roots & Shoots is a global community action program founded by Dr. Jane Goodall in 1991. It is a global movement that aims to bring together youth from all walks of life for one goal the betterment of our environment. The Roots & Shoots program aims to believe that everyone can make a positive change in the world, no matter where we come from, by coming together as a community and taking action.
